Silent Auction - At the event

1. To participate in the silent auction you must complete a bidder registration form at the registration table. (Preferably upon arrival) and provide your method of payment
2. All auction items will be listed by number in the catalog and on bid sheets. Buyer will enter bidder full name and dollar bid on these sheets. Please respect the opening bid amounts.
3. Bid as often as you want to, and on as many items as you would like to bid on. You may want to return to those items just before bidding closes.
4. Bids placed are an obligation to buy and may not be withdrawn.
5. Items will be awarded to the highest bidders on the bid sheets at the time the silent auction tables are closed.
6. Bid generously as a portion of your bid is tax deductible

Absentee Bidding

1. For those not able to attend the event on April 5th absentee bids will be accepted.
2. Absentee bids may be placed by calling Arlington Center for the Arts 781-648-6220 and providing your name, auction item number, your maximum bid and a credit card number to secure the bid (your card will not be charged unless you are the winning bidder)
3. Absentee bids are binding and may not be withdrawn.
4. Absentee bids will be accepted until **6 pm Thursday April 3rd.**
5. Winning absentee bidders will be notified by email or phone starting April 7th.
