The Arlington Center for the Arts is very pleased to offer scholarships throughout the year to children and adults. We recognize the importance of making arts and cultural experiences accessible to as broad an audience as possible, particularly to those in the communities we serve.

Our scholarships are on a sliding scale, based on income and upon our limited resources. Scholarships do not cover the costs of materials, transportation, or other related expenses. Scholarships are limited to 50% of tuition. The recipient must cover the other 50% of tuition in advance to secure their registration.

TO APPLY, PLEASE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

1) A brief letter of application detailing the following:

- The name of the applicant, specifying for an adult or child
- The semester, class/program you are requesting
- A second choice if the first request is unavailable
- A few sentences on why you feel a scholarship is needed

2) Please send a copy of your latest tax return (required). You may also send social security information or other documentation to help us decide on awarding a scholarship.

Due to limited resources, and if you qualify, we can only offer one scholarship per family per calendar year, up to 50% of the program cost.

Program	Amount of Scholarship
Classes (Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall)	50% of one class
February/April Vacation Arts Programs*	50% of one week
Summer Vacation Arts Programs*	50% up to two weeks

* You may include Extended Day costs in your scholarship request. Extended Day must be prepaid with tuition.
