Accessibility

Arlington Community Center has automated doors and elevator access to all levels. The 27 Maple Street entrance is wheelchair accessible and has a round driveway for easy drop offs. There are two ADA accessible parking spaces along Maple Street and several located behind the building in the parking lot. When you enter the building from 27 Maple St you will be on the ground floor. To reach the 1st floor where the Main Hall is located, you can turn left and proceed down the hallway for the elevator to the 1st floor. Our 20 Academy St entrance features a staircase with 12 steps leading into the 1st floor.

Admission

No admission is required for this event, but refreshments require payment.

Directions and Transportation

From Cambridge/Somerville: Take Mass. Ave. toward Arlington and past the Robbins Library (on your left). Academy Street is the first left as you pass the Robbins Library.

From Lexington: Take Mass. Ave. through Arlington Center. Take a right just before reaching Arlington Town Hall onto Academy St and our building will be on the left.

From Rt. 2: Take Exit 134 toward Rt 60/Arlington/Belmont. Follow Pleasant St/Rt.60 toward Arlington until it intersects with Mass. Ave. Take a left on Mass Ave, past the Robbins Library and take the first left onto Academy St.

Masking

Masking is not required for the Jug Band Festival spaces. Free masks are available at Arlington Center for the Arts' information table.

Parking

There is a parking lot in the rear of the Arlington Community Center building, which includes several accessible parking spaces. ACA shares this parking lot with multiple town offices and organizations. Parking spots can sometimes fill up quickly. If driving, we recommend giving yourself extra time to secure a spot in our lot or find alternative parking on the street or at the Russell Commons Municipal Lot, located at 29 Mystic Street, behind Arlington Center.

There is free, 4-hr, on-street parking on Academy St and Maple Street, and metered parking along the Mass Ave corridor. The Town of Arlington has [an interactive map](#) for those looking for municipal parking in the area.

Restrooms

There are several all-gender, wheelchair-accessible restrooms located on the first floor of the Arlington Community Center.

Seating

There are chairs available for seating in the Main Hall and in the hallway spaces.
